Make Good Choices Online

- ✓ Remember that anyone can post anything online. It might be true or not.

- ✓ Read, Think, And then Click. Do not click on suspicious links.

Be a Wise Consumer

- ✓ Spot the different kinds of online advertising. If a site asks me to buy a product, I will select no and tell my Teacher/Parent.

Think Before I Write

- ✓ Not share my real name, address or phone number on a website.
- ✓ Tell my teacher/parent if someone has posted harmful information about me.
- ✓ Be respectful and ask for permission when sharing information online.
- ✓ Remember that if I wouldn't post it on the school bulletin board, I won't post it online.



Keep it Secure

- ✓ Use a safe password with letters and numbers.
- ✓ Never share my passwords with friends.
- ✓ Never reply to emails or pop-ups that ask for your name or address.

Connect Safely

- ✓ Communicate with friends through email or online.
- ✓ Not respond if someone sends me a hurtful message online. I will ask my Teacher for help.
- ✓ Use safe and friendly usernames online.

Prevent CyberBullying

- ✓ Will not be a cyberbully. People do not deserve to be treated badly and cyberbullying really hurts others.
- ✓ Will apologize if I have made a mistake and posted something online that hurt someone.
- ✓ Be a friend and help by telling an adult if someone is being cyberbullied.
