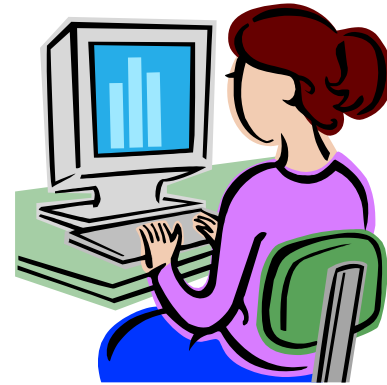
In *grade 6*, I will...

Think Before I Write

- Not share my real name, address or phone number on a website.
- Never post or send private information online.
- Never post or send messages about others online.
- Tell my teacher immediately if someone posts something negative about me.

Keep it Secure

- Use a safe password that is a combination of letters and numbers.
- Never share my password with others.
- Not open strange email messages or attachments.

Connect Safely

- Connect with friends through email or online.
- Use protective features – so only people who can send me a message know who I am.
- Keep my personal information off my social networking profile.

Be a Wise Consumer

- Will select no and tell my Teacher if a site asks me to buy a product.
- Never provide personal contact information if I have to register for a website.

Prevent Cyberbullying

- Pay attention to how I communicate with others online and be careful not to accidentally insult others.
- Not retaliate to online threats or postings.
- Save the message or image and show my Teacher immediately.
- Help a friend if they are being sent hurtful messages.
