<b>Screennames</b>	Your screen name cannot identify if any way. i.e. user1099	Your screen name may identify if you're male or female or give you clues to your identity. (i.e. John76)	Includes part of your name in combination with any other identifying personal information like your birthday, address, town, school, etc.	Includes your full name, parts of your address, or birthday.	
<b>Privacy Settings on social networking sites</b>	<p>No identifying information, such as birthday, address, full name, etc. You don't list your town, school, sports affiliations, etc. There is nothing that can identify where you are, who you are, and how old you are.</p> <p>You friend only people you know and only allow friends to see your information.</p> <p>You do not allow friends of friends to see your information.</p>	<p>No identifying information, such as birthday, address, full name, etc. You might say which city you live in, but you don't give your address. You might give your birthday, but don't give your year of birth.</p> <p>You friend only people you know, but you might allow friends of friends see your information.</p>	<p>There is information that can identify who you are and where you live, such your name, address, birthday, etc.</p> <p>You friend only people you know, but you keep your profile open to the public.</p>	<p>There is information that can identify who you are and where you live, such your name, address, birthday, etc.</p> <p>You friend anyone, even if you don't know them, and you keep your profile open to the public.</p>	
<b>The information you post</b>	You are unidentifiable. You cannot put a name, address, phone number, birthdate, (or birthplace) occupation, gender, school, family members, sports or group affiliation, hobbies to your screen name.	You cannot identify a full name, but you leave some clues behind as to your identity, such as your gender, birthday (month and day, but not year).	You give part or full name	You give your full name, and other easily identifiable information.	

<p><b>The media you post (i.e. photos, videos, etc.)</b></p>	<p>Your photos &amp; videos don't show your face or that of your friends.</p> <p>Your photos and videos show age appropriate behavior and don't contain any thing that will later embarrass you.</p>	<p>Your photos and videos show your face &amp; that of your friends, but do not identify you in anyway (and neither does your account information).</p> <p>The photos and videos are age appropriate, but might embarrass you at a later date.</p>	<p>Your photos and videos show your face &amp; that of your friends and leave clues behind to your identity or their identity.</p> <p>Your photos and videos are not age appropriate</p>	<p>Your photos and videos show all and tell all.</p> <p>Your photos and videos are not age appropriate and will later embarrass you.</p>
